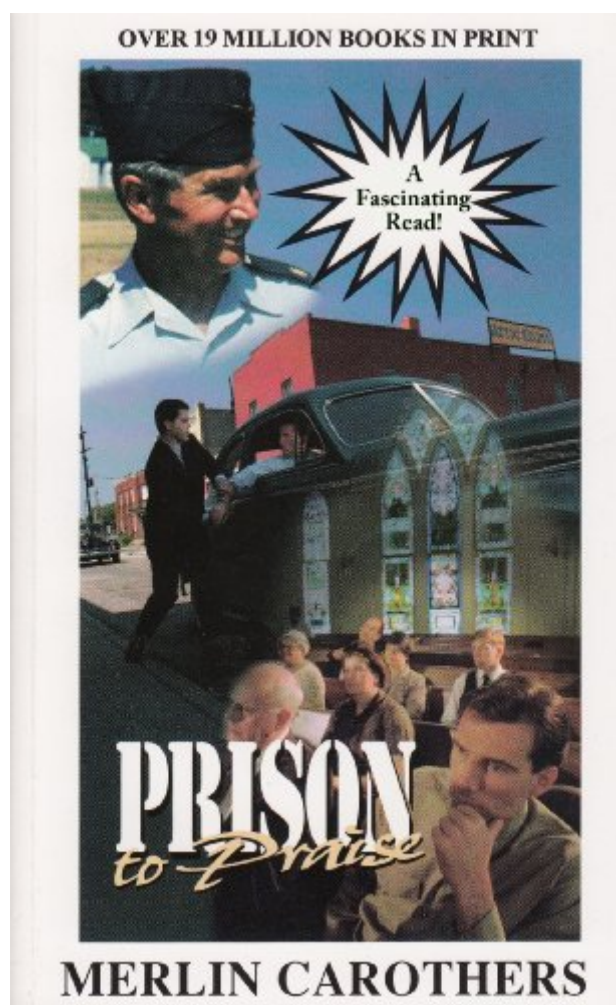

He also points out this is superior form of spiritual communion with Lord. He draws attention to the fact that baptism by Holy Spirit may be needed for such effective Praise giving.
