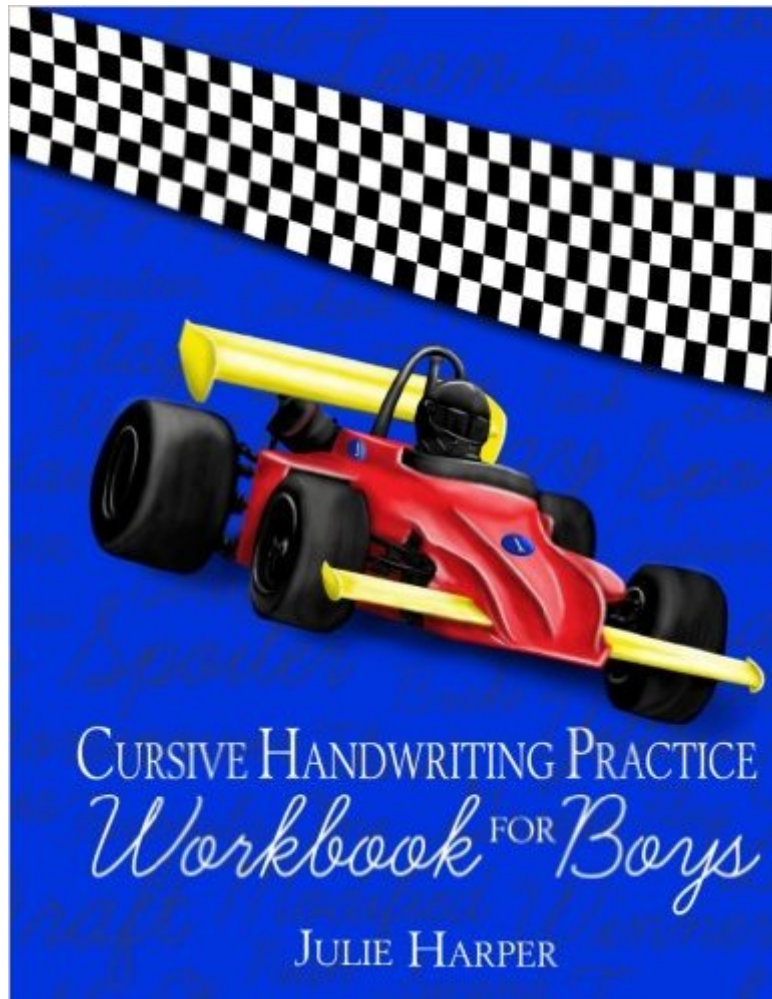

At this stage, there is no tracing. May your students or children improve their handwriting skills and enjoy reading and writing these boyish phrases and sentences.
