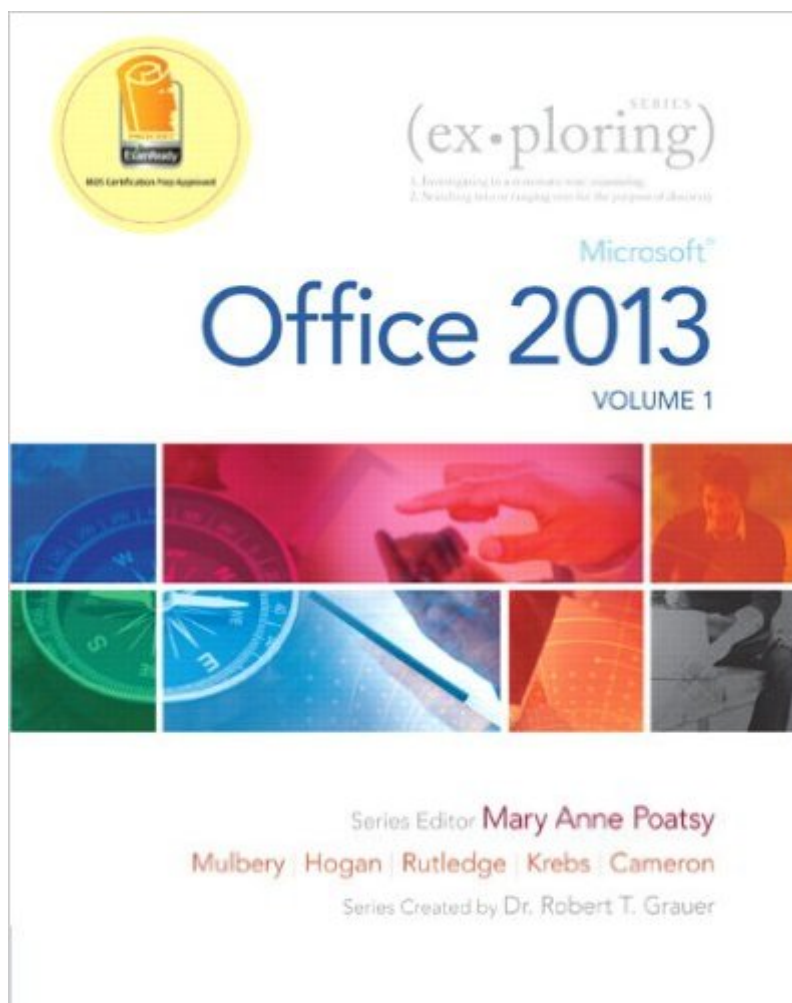

Well organized text. The examples were clear and the directions on how to proceed well written.
