

"The earliest reports of payments with cowrie shells were from China about 3,500 years ago."The first thing I noticed on the first page was the heart-shaped English brass halfpenny token from 1665. I've seen a lot of coins, but had no idea that they could be in so many shapes. From the Ancient Chinese bronze hoe-shaped coin of the 6th century to the square Indian gold mohur of the 17th century, there is a coin for every taste and collection. There is information on funny money, the first coins, paper money, how coins are made, how banknotes are made, forgery and fakes, money and trade, money in war, power, shared currencies, checks and plastic and coin collections. The countries features include ancient cultures, France, Germany, Netherlands, Belgium, Italy, Spain, Portugal, Greece, Turkey, Denmark, Norway, Sweden, Finland, United Kingdom, United States of America, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, China, Japan and African countries."The name for a piggy bank comes from pygg, a type of clay used in Middle Ages to make pots for money and other thing. The idea to make banks in the shape of pigs probably came from the similarity of the words."If we could still pay with shells, many of us would probably spend a lot more time at the beach. Some of the most fascinating "money" in this book includes red feathers glued together and tied onto vegetable-fiber coils. Writing a check on a cow? That has tobe the strangest thing I've heard about money. This book has the most bizarre tales about money and also has a special section on coin collecting, how to store them and why you should note store them in a plastic envelope.

Wow! This book is crammed pack with facts on money, new and old plus hundreds of photos. So what do you want to know?Money can be many different things, not just bills, coins and cards like many of us are used to today. How about some money made from feathers? Maybe a bar of rock salt would serve you better?The first known coins were made in what is now Turkey, around 7 B.C. The first paper money came from the Chinese in the 11th century. Four pages are dedicated to showing how coins and banknotes are made - totally fascinating. Of course you can't learn about how they are made without learning about forgeries and fakes!The power of money - is it really the root of all evil? Where there is crime there is money! Have you ever seen a million dollars? You will in this book! What a shame we just can't lift it out of the picture?!Despite the fact that much of Europe is now using one currency, the Euro, this book details the old currencies of the following countries each on a double page spread.
