This is a wonderful tool for in the classroom or at home to help young writers learn the different parts of a story and how to develop their own. It uses "Little Red Riding Hood" as an example to follow so the story is something familiar.

This book is a must-have when teaching kids how to write fairy tales!! The kids loved the book and we ended up creating a graphic organizer with the 13 tools for writing a great fairy tale to help plan our stories!!
